

# Inflation at 3.4% in 2020

The annual inflation rate of consumer prices in Saudi Arabia stood at 3.4% in 2020, largely driven by the effects of an increase in the Value Added Tax (VAT) from 5% to 15% in July 2020. The main driver of inflation were prices of Food and Beverages (+9.0%) and Transport (+3.8%).

#### Food prices drive inflation in 2020

- Prices of Food and Beverages recorded a 9.0% increase in 2020, which in turn was influenced by a 11.5% rise in meat and poultry prices, as well as vegetable prices by 17.1%.
- Tobacco recorded a rise by 7.1% due to a 6.2% increase in cigarette prices.
- Prices of **Communication** recorded a 4.8% increase, mainly resulting from the rise in the price of telephone and fax services by 5.9%.
- Prices of Furnishings, Household Equipment and Household Maintenance increased by 4.6%.
- Transport prices recorded a rise of 3.8% due to 7.0% increase in vehicle purchase prices.
- **Miscellaneous Goods and Services** prices increased by 4.0% due to the increase in the prices of jewelry, watches and precious antiques by 16.8%.

#### Housing rents and education costs decline in 2020

- Housing, Water, Electricity, Gas and other Fuels decreased by -0.6%, due to the decrease of housing rents by -1.0%.
- Education costs recorded a decrease of 2.0%, which is due to reductions in the prices of pre and primary education (-1.6%) and middle and secondary Education (-3.4%).
