



# IPI increases by 7.9% in June 2025

Preliminary results indicate a 7.9% increase in the Industrial Production Index (IPI) in June 2025 compared to the same month of the previous year (June 2024), supported by the rise in mining and quarrying activity, manufacturing activity, electricity, gas, steam, and air conditioning supply activity and water supply, sewerage and waste management and remediation activities. On a monthly basis, the index increased by 1.6%.

### Sub-index of mining and quarrying activity

In June 2025, the sub-index of mining and quarrying activity increased by 6.0% compared to the same month of the previous year. Saudi Arabia increased its oil production to 9.36 million barrels per day in June 2025 compared to 8.83 million barrels per day in June 2024. On a monthly basis, the sub-index of mining and quarrying activity increased by 1.9%.

### Sub-index of manufacturing activity

Compared to June of the previous year, the sub-index of manufacturing activity increased by 11.1%, supported by an increase in the manufacture of coke and refined petroleum products which increased by 15.3%, and manufacture of chemicals and chemical products which increased by 18.7%.

On a monthly basis, the sub-index of manufacturing activity showed an increase of 1.4%, supported by the rise in the activity of the manufacture of coke and refined petroleum products, which increased by 1.7%, and the manufacture of chemicals and chemical products which increased by 2.0%.

# Sub-index of electricity, gas, steam, and air conditioning supply, and sub-index of water supply, sewage and waste management and remediation activities

The sub-index of electricity, gas, steam, and air conditioning supply activity recorded an annual increase of 5.6%, and the sub-index of water supply, sewerage and waste management and remediation activities increased by 6.9%.

Based on the month-on-month trend, the sub-index of electricity, gas, steam, and air conditioning supply activity decreased by 0.6%, and the sub-index of water supply, sewerage and waste management and remediation activities increased by 2.8%.

### IPI by main economic activities

The index of oil activities in June 2025 increased by 7.7% compared to the same month of the previous year. The index of non-oil activities increased by 8.6%. Based on the month-on-month trend, the index for oil activities increased by 1.9%, and the index of non-oil activities increased by 1.1%.

Figure 3. Monthly growth rate of sub-indices according to ISIC4-June 2025





Figure 4. IPI by main economic activities
