

Operating Revenues Index increases by 4.9% in July 2026

Preliminary results indicated a 4.9% increase in the Operating Revenues Index compared to the same month of the previous year (July 2025). On a monthly basis, the Index increased by 1.2% compared to June 2026. Issued building permits recorded an annual increase of 4.4% compared to the same month last year and a monthly increase of 15.5% compared to June 2026.

Operating Revenues Index in July 2026

The Operating Revenues Index increased by 4.9% year-on-year, supported by increases of 13.5% in manufacturing activities, 0.8% in wholesale and retail trade; repair of motor vehicles and motorcycles activities, 1.6% in construction activities, and increases of 9.0% and 6.5% in financial and insurance activities and information and communication activities, respectively.

On a monthly basis, the Operating Revenues Index increased by 1.2%, supported by increases of 0.8% in manufacturing activities, 6.4% in mining and quarrying activities, 0.1% in construction activities, and increases of 3.7% and 0.6% in information and communication activities and accommodation and food service activities, respectively.

Figure1. Operating Revenues Index and annual change rates

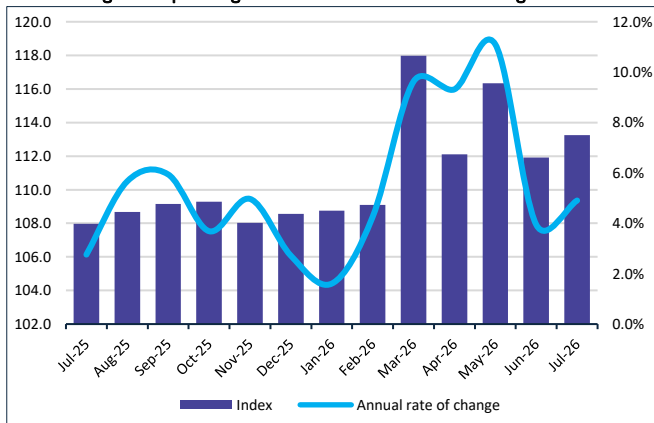
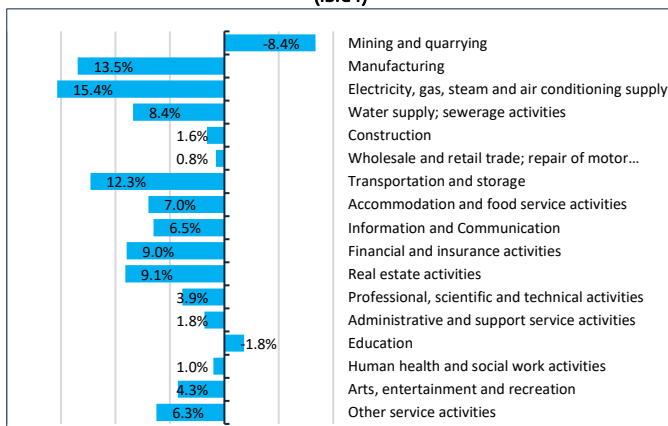


Figure 2. Annual change rate for Operating Revenues Index by economic activities (ISIC4)



Employees Compensation Index

The Employees Compensation Index increased by 7.4% year-on-year, supported by increases of 10.3% in manufacturing activities, 4.6% in construction activities, 6.2% in wholesale and retail trade and repair of motor vehicles and motorcycles activities, and increases of 2.7% and 6.4% in mining and quarrying activities and financial and insurance activities, respectively.

On a monthly basis, the Employees Compensation Index increased by 0.3%, supported by increases of 0.3% in mining and quarrying activities, 0.1% in financial and insurance activities, 0.8% in transportation and storage activities, and increases of 1.8% and 2.6% in information and communication activities and human health and social work activities, respectively.

Figure 3. Employees Compensation Index and annual rates

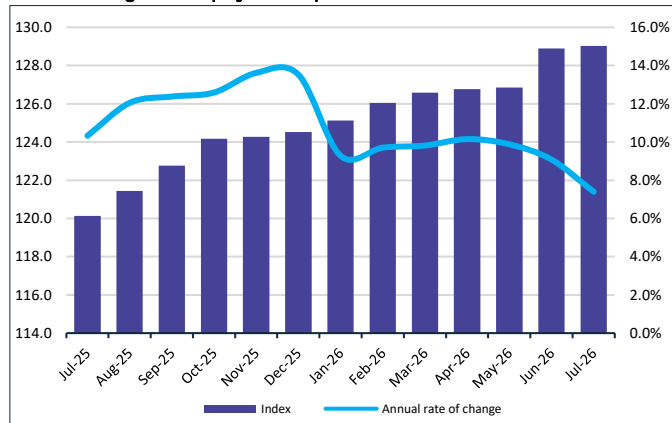
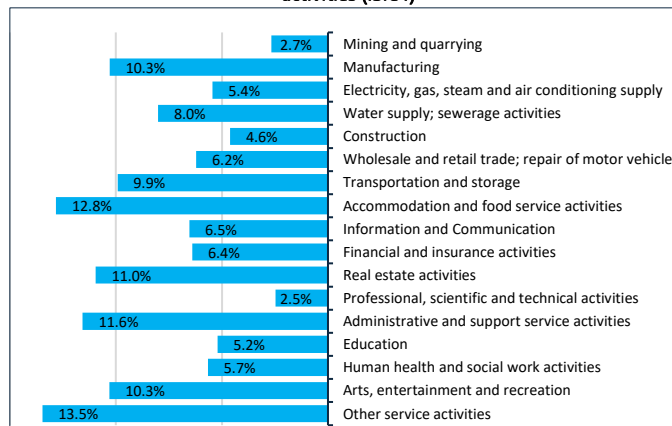


Figure 4. Annual change rate for Employees Compensation Index by economic activities (ISIC4)

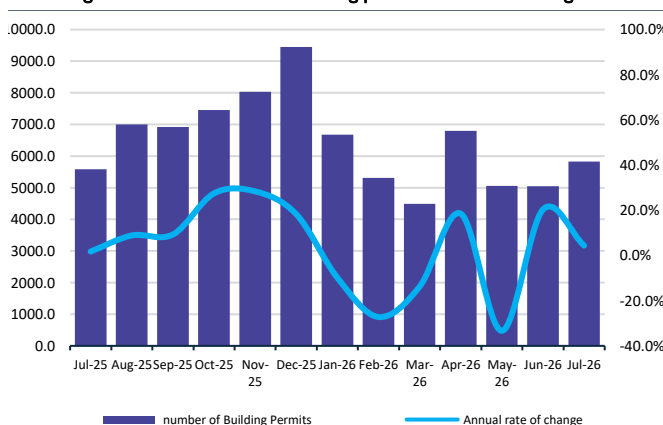


Issued building permits

In July 2026, the number of issued building permits increased by 4.4% compared to the same month of the previous year, increasing from 5,582 permits in July 2025 to 5,828 permits.

Compared to June 2026, the number of issued building permits also increased from 5,045 permits to 5,828 permits, a monthly increase of 15.5%
