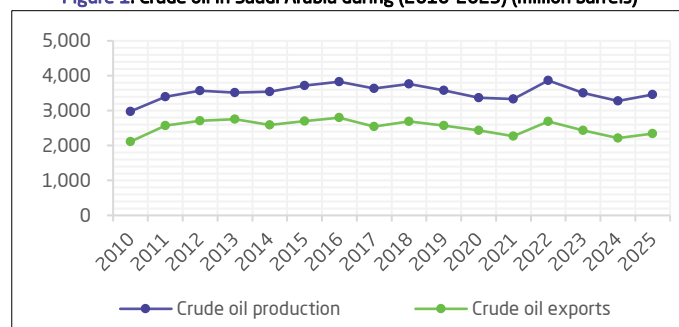


Increase in production and export levels in the oil sector in 2025

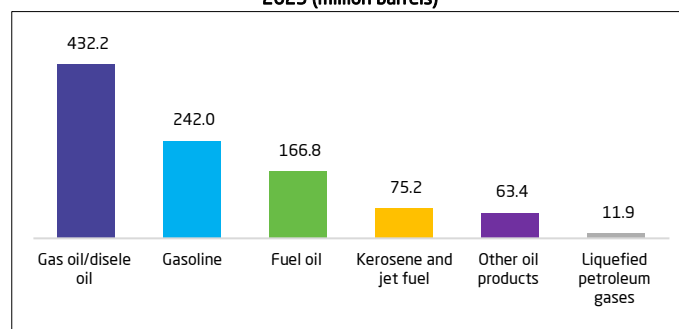
Figure 1. Crude oil in Saudi Arabia during (2010-2025) (million barrels)

The Oil and Gas Statistics 2025 showed that the total crude oil production in Saudi Arabia reached approximately 3,461.8 million barrels, recording a growth of 5.6% compared to 2024. Crude oil exports reached approximately 2,347.3 million barrels, an increase of 6.0%. In contrast, crude oil consumption totaled 155.4 million barrels, a decrease of 6.7% compared to 2024 (**Figure 1**).

Domestic production of refined petroleum products

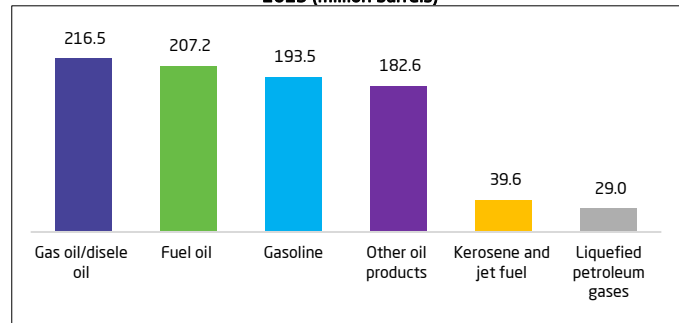
Figure 2. Domestic production of refined petroleum products in Saudi Arabia for 2025 (million barrels)

The total production of refined petroleum products in Saudi Arabia reached 991.5 million barrels in 2025. Gas oil/diesel oil production increased to 432.2 million barrels, representing a growth rate of 6.0% compared to 2024. Gasoline production increased to 242.0 million barrels, recording a growth of 1.6% compared to 2024, while fuel oil production amounted to 166.8 million barrels (**Figure 2**).

Domestic consumption of refined petroleum products

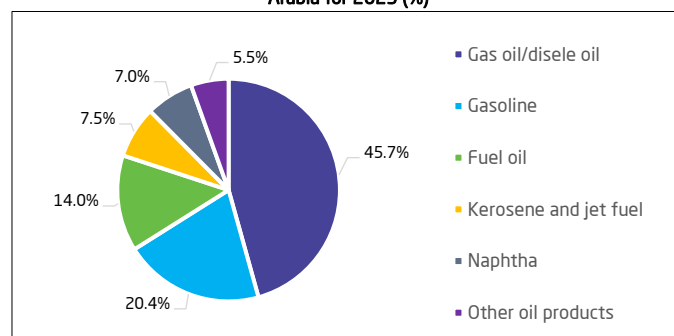
Figure 3. Domestic consumption of refined petroleum products in Saudi Arabia for 2025 (million barrels)

The total consumption of refined petroleum products in Saudi Arabia reached 868.4 million barrels in 2025. Gas oil/diesel oil reached 216.5 million barrels, recording a decline of 3.4% compared to 2024. Fuel oil consumption also declined to 207.2 million barrels, representing a decrease of 13.0% compared to 2024. Meanwhile, gasoline consumption amounted to 193.5 million barrels (**Figure 3**).

Exports of refined petroleum products

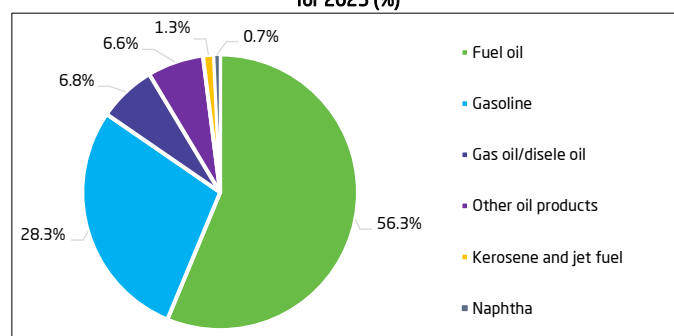
Figure 4. Relative distribution of refined petroleum product exports in Saudi Arabia for 2025 (%)

The oil and Gas Statistics 2025 showed that the total exports of refined petroleum products exceeded 541 million barrels. Gas oil/diesel oil exports accounted for the largest share of total refined petroleum product exports, reaching 247.3 million barrels, representing 45.7% of the total. This was followed by gasoline exports, which amounted to 110.5 million barrels, representing 20.4% of total exports, while fuel oil exports reached 75.7 million barrels, representing 14.0% of total exports (**Figure 4**).

Imports of refined petroleum products

Total imports of refined petroleum products amounted to 129.6 million barrels in 2025. Fuel oil imports accounted for the largest share of total imports, reaching 72.9 million barrels, equivalent to 56.3% of the total imports. This was followed by gasoline imports, which amounted to 36.7 million barrels, representing 28.3% of the total imports, while gas oil/diesel oil imports reached 8.8 million barrels, accounting for 6.8% of total imports (**Figure 5**).

The data are available as a time series for the period 2010-2025 and are presented on a monthly basis, while the publication is issued annually.
