

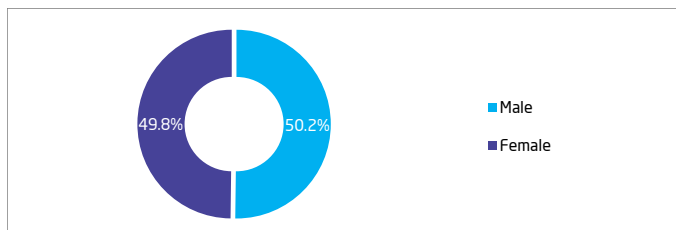
Number of Umrah performers exceeds 5 million in Q2 of 2025

Statistics showed that the total number of external and internal Umrah performers during Q2 of 2025 reached 5,524,091, including 3,404,361 males and 2,119,730 females. The number of internal Umrah performers amounted to 4,118,975, of whom 2,698,993 were males and 1,419,982 were females. Among internal Umrah performers, the number of Saudi Umrah performers reached 2,125,701, representing 51.6% of total internal Umrah performers. Meanwhile, the number of external Umrah performers reached 1,405,116.

External Umrah performers by gender

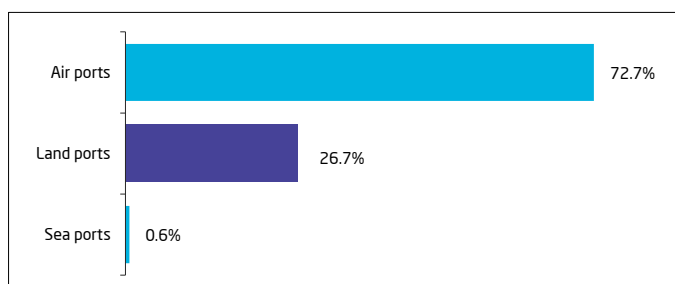
Figure 1. Distribution of external Umrah performers by gender (%)

Data showed that the total number of external Umrah performers during Q2 of 2025 reached 1,405,116. The number of male Umrah performers amounted to 705,368, representing 50.2%, while the number of female Umrah performers reached 699,748, accounting for 49.8% of the total (Figure 1).

External Umrah performers by entry ports

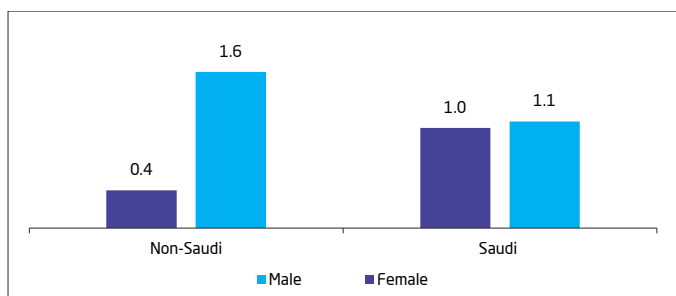
Figure 2. Distribution of external Umrah performers entry ports (%)

Statistics showed that 72.7% of external Umrah performers entered through airports, while 26.7% arrived through land ports, and 0.6% came through seaports, representing the total number of external Umrah performers (Figure 2).

Internal Umrah performers by gender and nationality

The total number of internal Umrah performers during Q2 of 2025 reached approximately 4,118,975. The number of Saudi Umrah performers amounted to 2,125,701, representing 51.6% of the total internal Umrah performers, while the number of non-Saudi Umrah performers reached 1,993,274, accounting for (48.4%). The results also indicated that the number of male internal Umrah performers was about 2,698,993, representing 65.5% of total internal Umrah performers, whereas the number of female internal Umrah performers amounted to approximately 1,419,982, accounting for 34.5% (Figure 3).

Patterns for internal Umrah performers by accompanying groups

Results showed that 62.9% of internal Umrah performers performed Umrah with their families, while 28.7% performed individually. In contrast, performing Umrah with friends represented the lowest percentage, accounting for 8.4% of the total internal Umrah performers during Q2 of 2025.

Internal Umrah performers by administrative region

According to the results of the statistical survey, Umrah performers from Makkah Region represented the highest percentage of internal Umrah performers during Q2 of 2025, reaching 1,773,820, accounting for 43.1% of total internal Umrah performers. The number of Umrah performers from Riyadh Region reached 602,244, representing 14.6% of the total. Meanwhile, the number of Umrah performers from Northern Borders Region amounted to 9,302, accounting for 0.2% of total internal Umrah performers during Q2 of 2025.

Internal Umrah performers by frequency

The number of internal Umrah performers who performed Umrah once reached 4,094,537, with males representing 65.7% and females accounting for 34.3%. Meanwhile, the number of internal Umrah performers who performed Umrah more than once during Q2 of 2025 amounted to 24,438, representing 0.6% of total internal Umrah performers during the same period of 2025.

External and internal Umrah performers by month

Statistics showed that April recorded the highest number of external Umrah performers during Q2 of 2025, accounting for 62.8%, with 832,298 Umrah performers. In contrast, May recorded the lowest number of external Umrah performers, with 197,800. As for internal Umrah performers, the results indicated that April also topped the months during Q2 in terms of the number of Umrah performers, recording 2,147,704, which represents 52.1% of total internal Umrah performers during the same period. Meanwhile, June ranked lowest, with 907,914 internal Umrah performers.

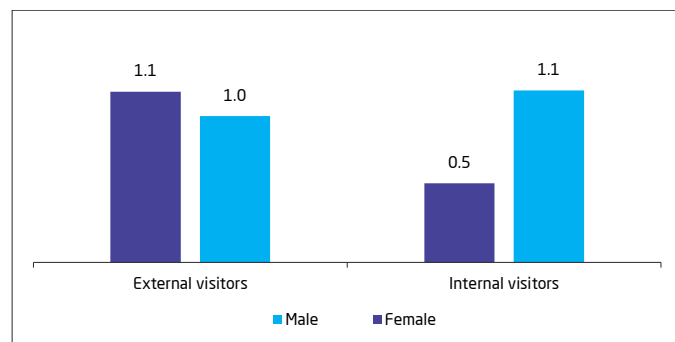
External and internal Umrah performers by age group

Umrah performers aged 35-44 years represented the highest percentage of external Umrah performers during Q2 of 2025, accounting for 17.7% of the total, according to administrative data. The age group above 65 years constituted the lowest percentage, representing 9.6%. On the other hand, internal Umrah performers aged 35-44 years recorded the highest share among internal Umrah performers during Q2 of 2025, accounting for 24.7%, according to the results of the statistical survey. Meanwhile, internal Umrah performers aged above 65 years represented the lowest percentage, accounting for 2.7%.

External and internal visitors to Medina

Statistics showed that the total number of external visitors to Madinah during Q2 of 2025 reached 2,102,425 visitors, with males representing 46.1% and females accounting for (53.9%). The results also indicated that the total number of internal visitors to Madinah for religious purposes during the same period reached 1,665,341 visitors, including 766,165 Saudi visitors (representing 46% of the total) and 899,176 non-Saudi visitors residing in the Kingdom (representing 54%). Among internal visitors, males constituted 68.5%, while females accounted for 31.5% (Figure 4).
