Indicator Description:

Cellular phone subscriptions per 100 inhabitants

Cellular phone subscribers are the people who use mobile phones to automatically receive cellular phone services and use cellular technologies, which give access to the public switched telephone network (PSTN). Users covered by this definition are the postpaid and prepaid line subscribers.

Indicator Calculating Methodology:

The total number of cellular phone subscriptions per inhabitants is calculated as follows:

Cellular phone subscriptions per 100 inhabitants $=\frac{\text{Number of cellular phone subscriptions}}{\text{Population}}*100$
