Merchandise Exports and Imports of The Kingdom of Saudi Arabia

February 2019



Reports



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Introduction

This report presents the developments in merchandise exports and imports of the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia for February 2019 as compared to the same period of the previous year, February 2018, according to the statistical methods and various classifications. The data for this report were collected from the Saudi Customs and the Ministry of Energy, Industry, and Mineral Resources.

All the data contained in this report and more details are attached to this report in an Excel file, which could be downloaded from the website of the General Authority for Statistics. ([GaStat](#))

It should be noted that the statistics presented in this report are preliminary and they may undergo some modifications in case of a data update.

Note: There might be some differences in the aggregates of numbers or percentages due to rounding.



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Methodology

Description

This report presents the statistics on exports and imports of the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia for the latest month with available data in comparison with the same period from last year. It highlights the main developments with summary tables and charts. Given the importance of oil exports to the Saudi economy, total exports are separated into oil exports and non-oil exports. Non-oil exports and imports are then presented in various classifications such as by section (HS), by group of countries, by partner countries, by means of transport and customs port. Appendix tables are also given at the end of the report and in a separate Excel file that could be downloaded from the GaStat website.

Data Collection, Processing, and Dissemination

The General Authority for Statistics receives the monthly data from two sources; (i) Saudi Customs and (ii) Ministry of Energy, Industry, and Mineral Resources.

The data pass through several stages of treatment before dissemination, as explained below.

First Stage:

Entering the data on the system of foreign trade statistics to obtain a preliminary review of commodities, countries, and customs centers to ensure consistency and comprehensiveness of the data.

Second Stage:

The implementation of processing programs for detailed customs data, through the application of auditing rules and automatic correction to extract notes. These notes are either processed directly by expert statisticians in the Department of Foreign Trade Statistics or investigated from its official source. This stage continues until the monthly data is completely audited and corrected.

Third Stage:

Aggregation of monthly data by commodity and country automatically by means of programs dedicated to this purpose. After that, a final and comprehensive review is conducted and thus the data become ready to be published.

Fourth Stage:

Various tables for different classifications are extracted from the system to prepare the monthly report. The report is published on a regular basis every month on the GaStat website.

Classification Used

The basic data on the foreign trade included in this report is based on the Harmonized Commodity Description and Coding Systems, known as the Harmonized System (HS).





Concepts and Definitions

Exports (Total):

Exports consist of exports of domestic goods (national exports) and exports of foreign goods (re-exports). Valuation is on Free-on-Board (FOB) basis.

National Exports:

Exports of all goods fully produced or manufactured in the country or undergone some modifications that lead to a change in their shapes and values.

Re-exports:

Refers to the sale of previously imported goods abroad without any clear modifications on them.

Oil Exports:

Exports of goods classified in Chapter 27 (mineral fuels, mineral oils and products of their distillation; bituminous substances; mineral waxes) of the Harmonized System (HS).

Non-oil Exports:

Total exports minus exports of goods classified in Chapter 27 (mineral fuels, mineral oils and products of their distillation; bituminous substances; mineral waxes) of the Harmonized System (HS).



Imports:

Refer to all goods entering the country after passing through the customs procedures to meet its local needs. Valuation is on Cost, Insurance, and Freight (CIF) basis.

Trade Volume:

The sum of exports and imports.

Trade Balance:

Total exports minus imports.

Non-oil Trade Balance:

Non-oil exports minus imports.

Monthly change:

Change from the previous month.

Annual change:

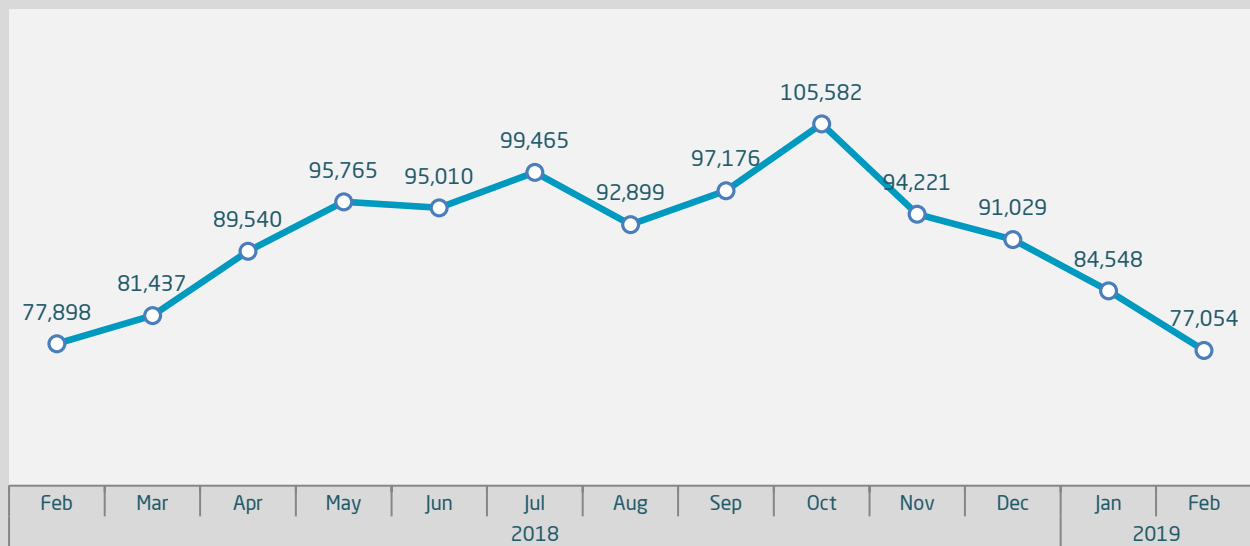
Change from the same month of the previous year.



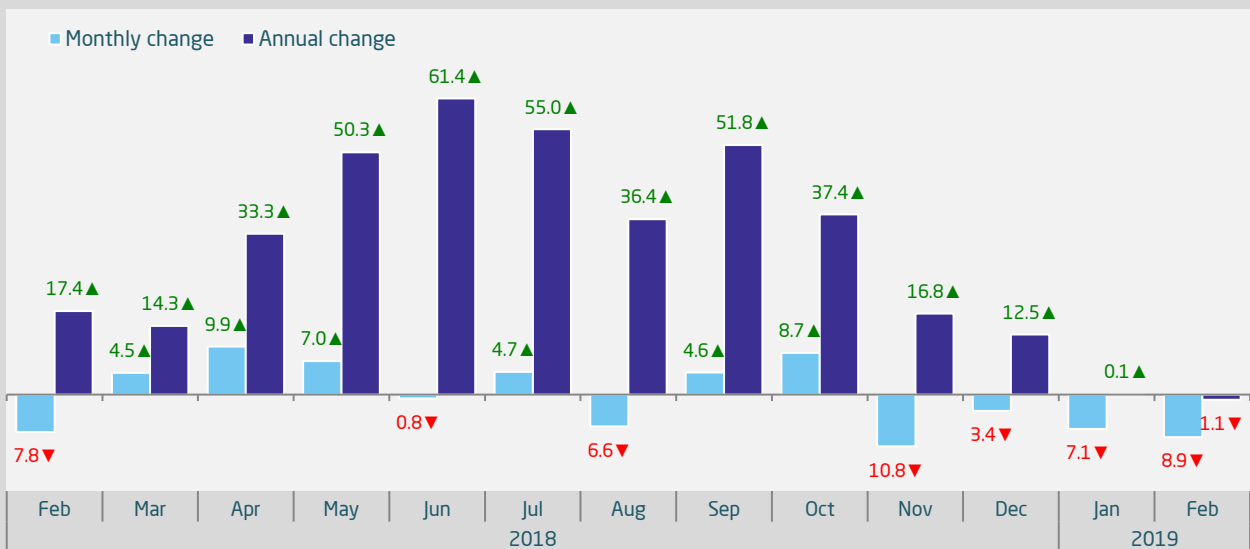
1. Merchandise Exports

Total merchandise exports of Saudi Arabia amounted to 77 billion 54 million riyals in February 2019 compared to 77 billion 898 million riyals in February 2018, corresponding to a decrease of 844 million riyals or 1.1% over that period. Merchandise exports in February 2019 were also lower than those in the preceding month (January 2019) by 7 billion 494 million riyals or 8.9%.

Change in Exports (%)

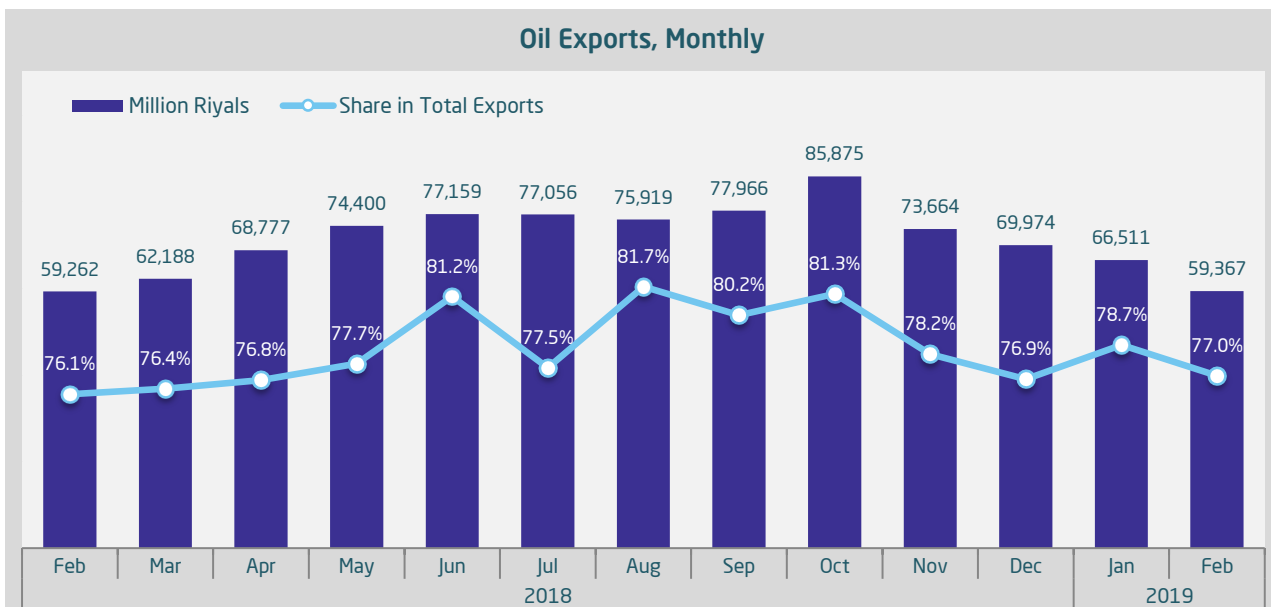




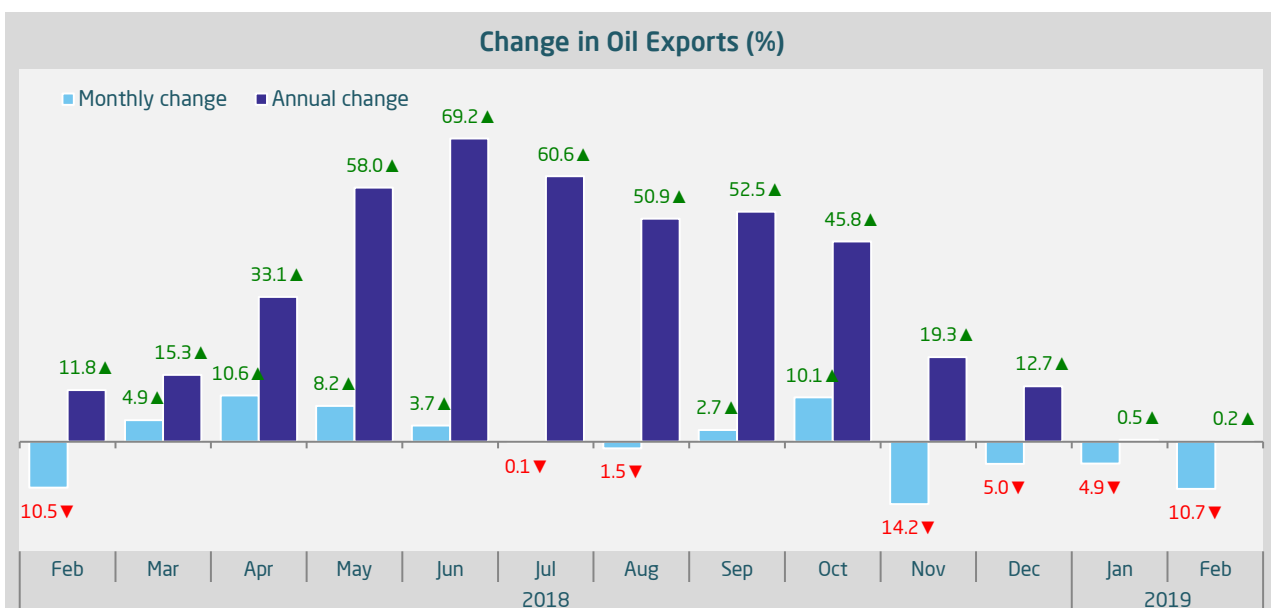
1.1. Oil Exports

Oil exports of Saudi Arabia valued at 59 billion 367 million riyals in February 2019 compared to 59 billion 262 million riyals in February 2018, corresponding to an increase of 105 million riyals or 0.2% over that period. The share of oil exports in total merchandise exports also increased from 76.1% in February 2018 to 77.0% in February 2019.

Compared to the previous month (January 2019), the value of oil exports decreased by 7 billion 144 million riyals or 10.7% in February 2019.



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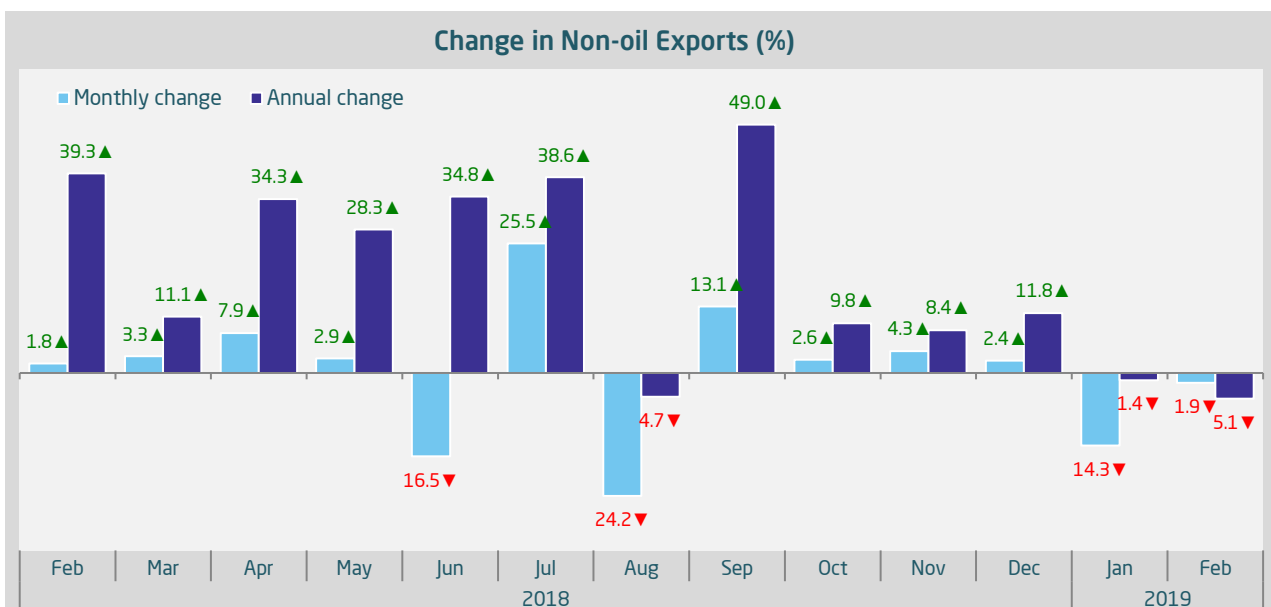
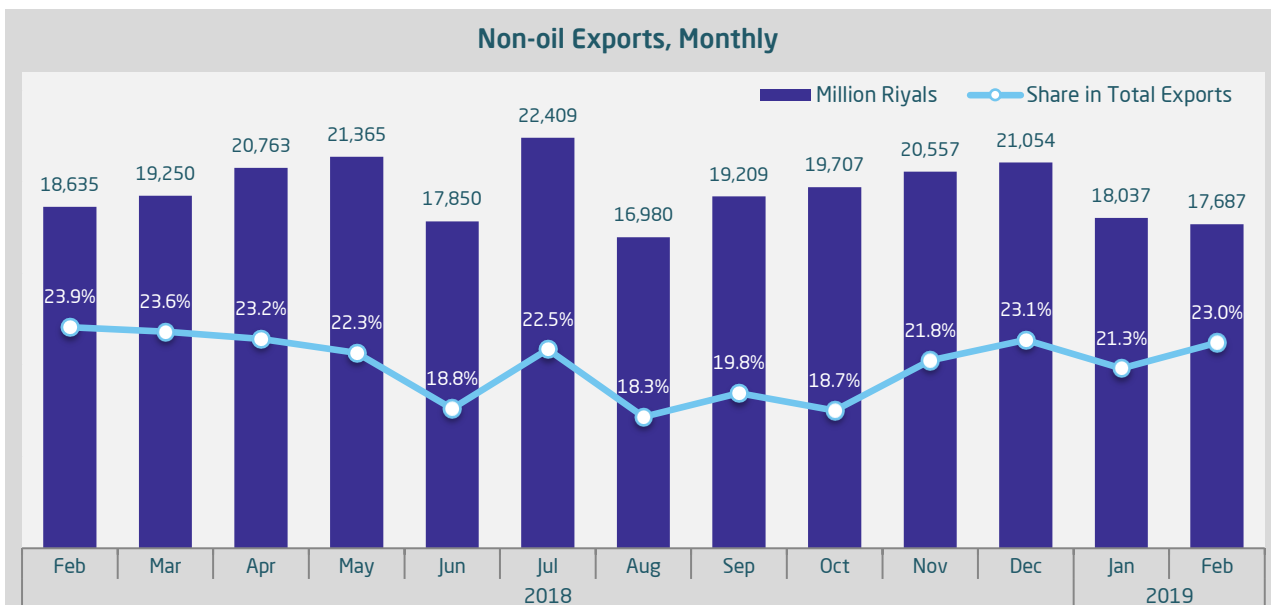


1.2. Non-oil Merchandise Exports

1.2.1. Developments in Non-oil Exports

Non-oil exports of Saudi Arabia amounted to 17 billion 687 million riyals in February 2019 compared to 18 billion 635 million riyals in February 2018, corresponding to a decrease of 949 million riyals or 5.1% over that period. The share of non-oil exports in total merchandise exports also decreased from 23.9% in February 2018 to 23.0% in February 2019.

Compared to the previous month (January 2019), the value of non-oil exports decreased by 350 million riyals or 1.9% in February 2019.



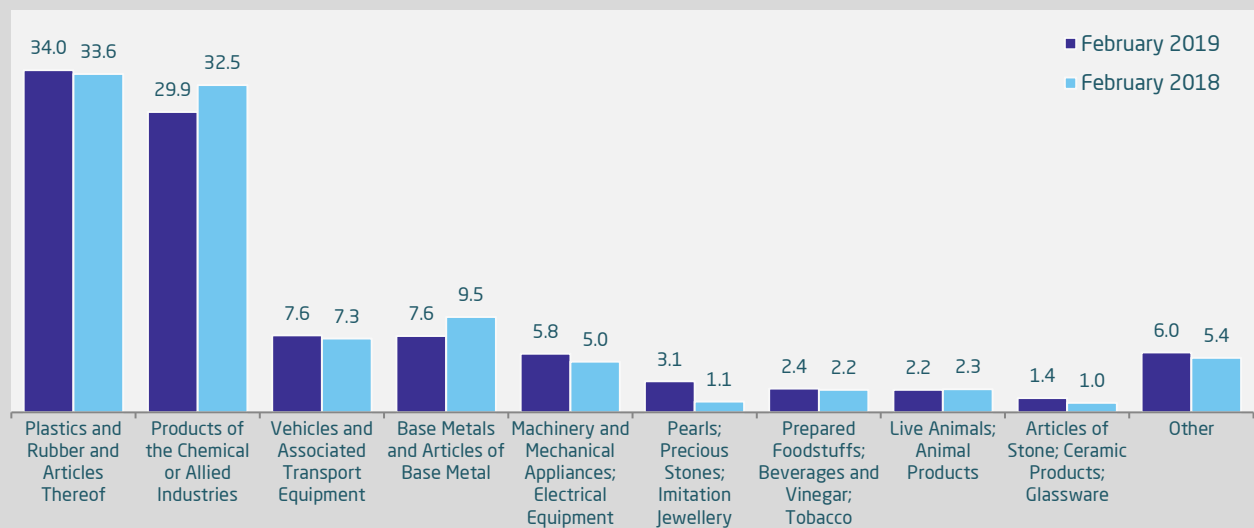

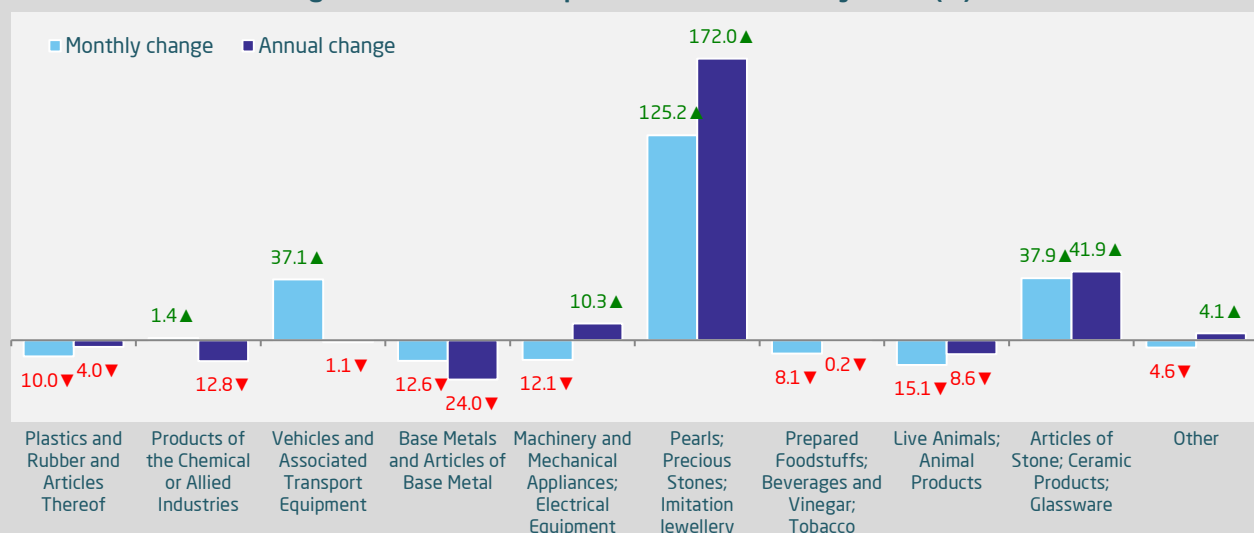

Change in Main Non-oil Export Products, February 2019 (%)

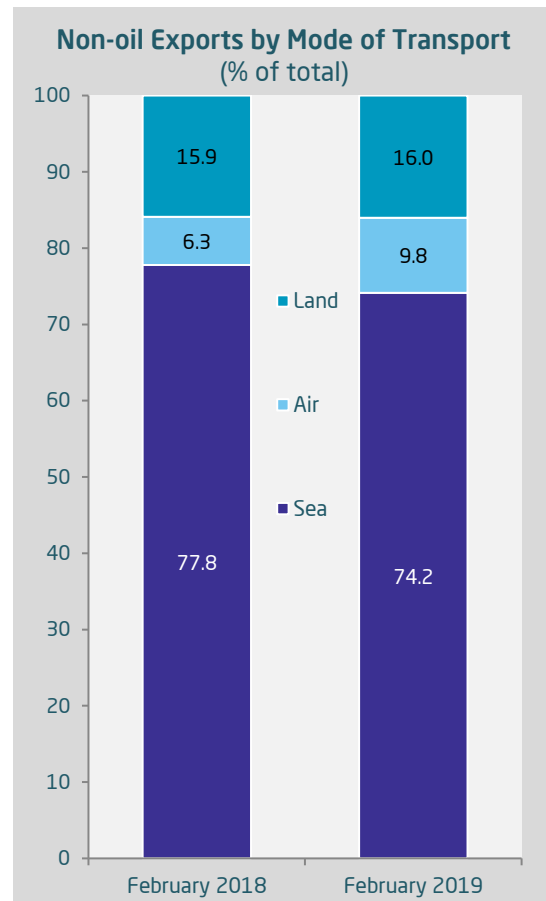
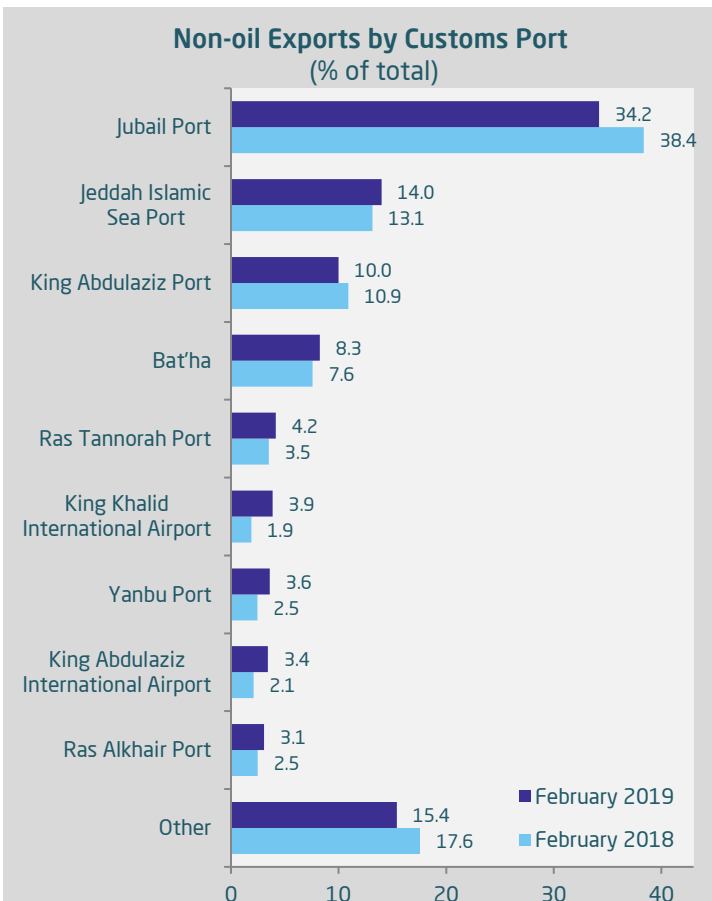

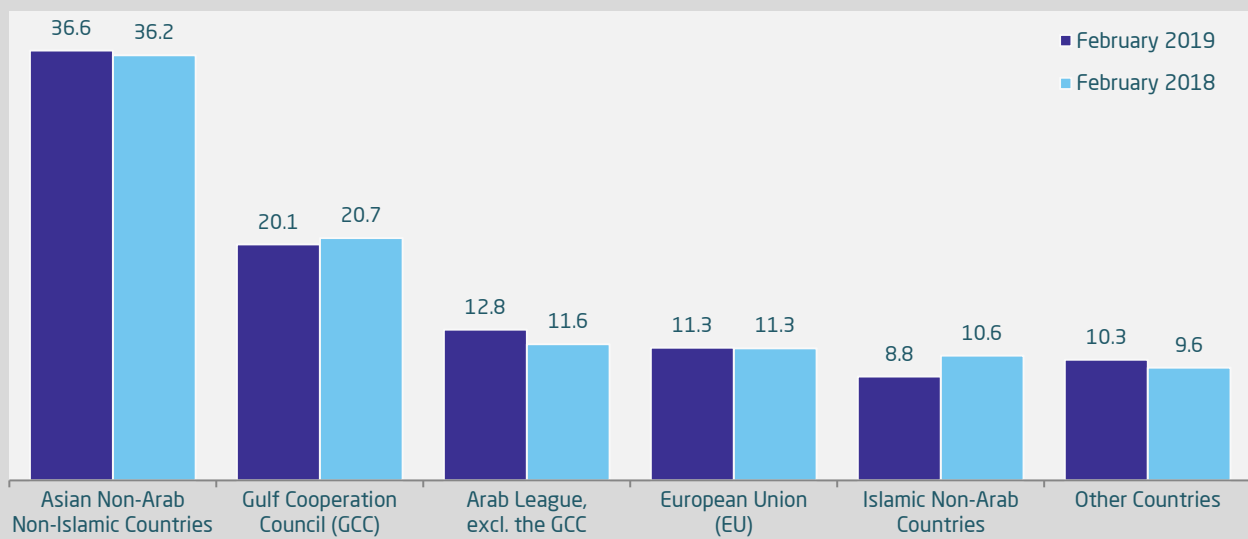

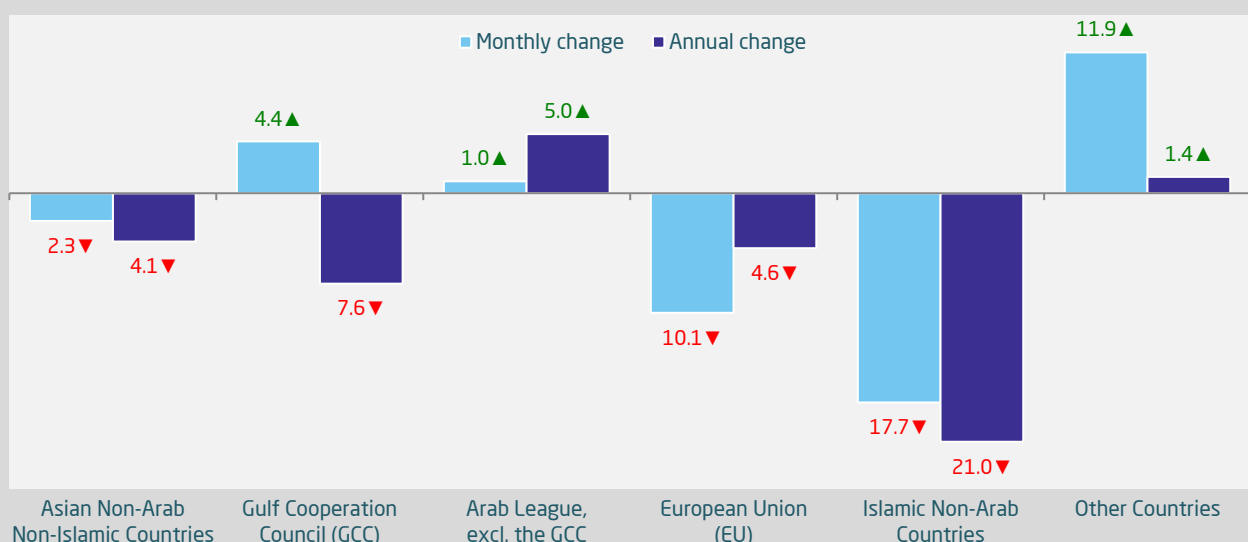

Change in Non-oil Exports by Group of Countries, February 2019 (%)



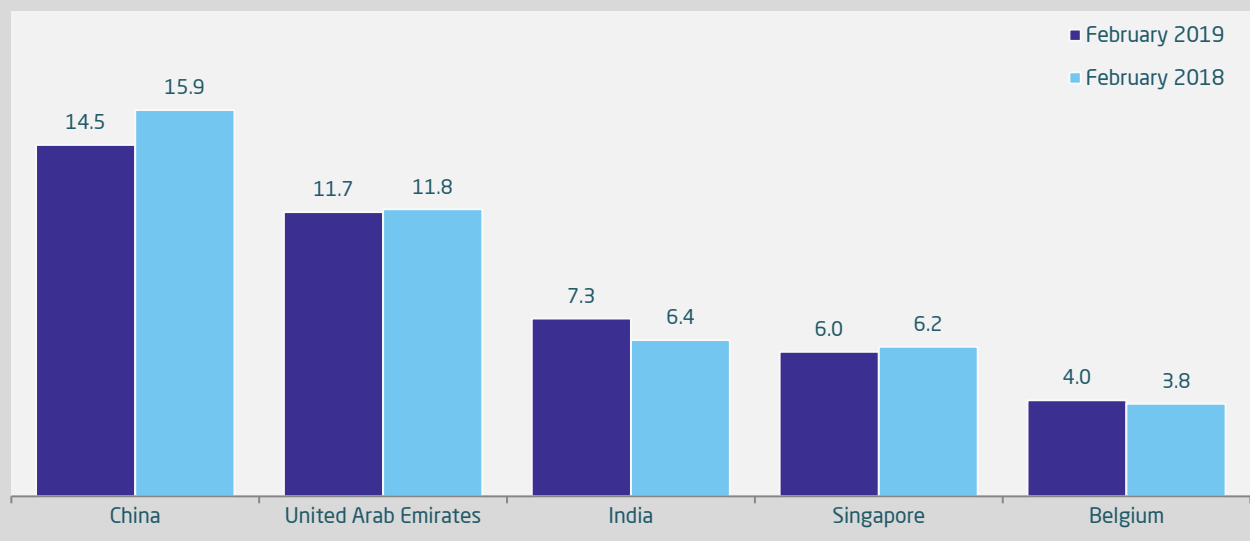

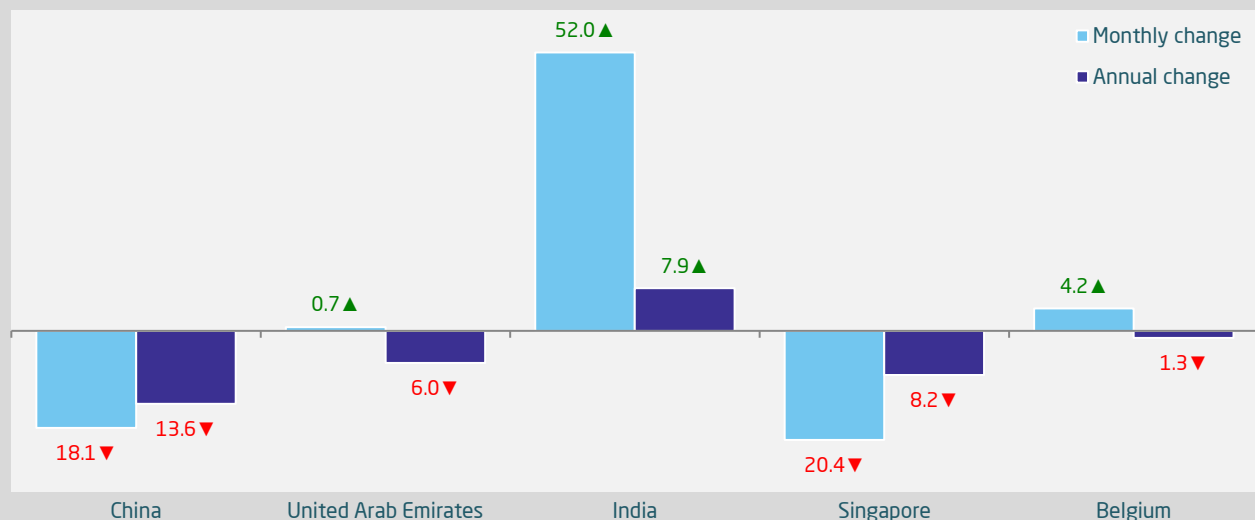

Change in Non-oil Exports to Top 5 Countries, February 2019 (%)

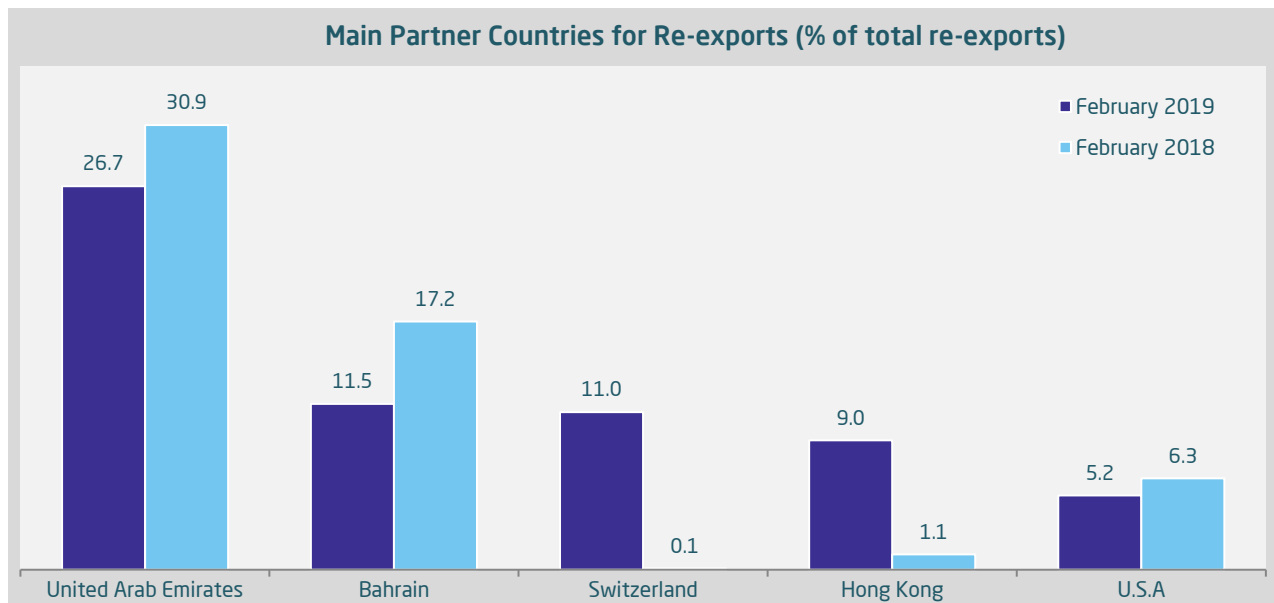
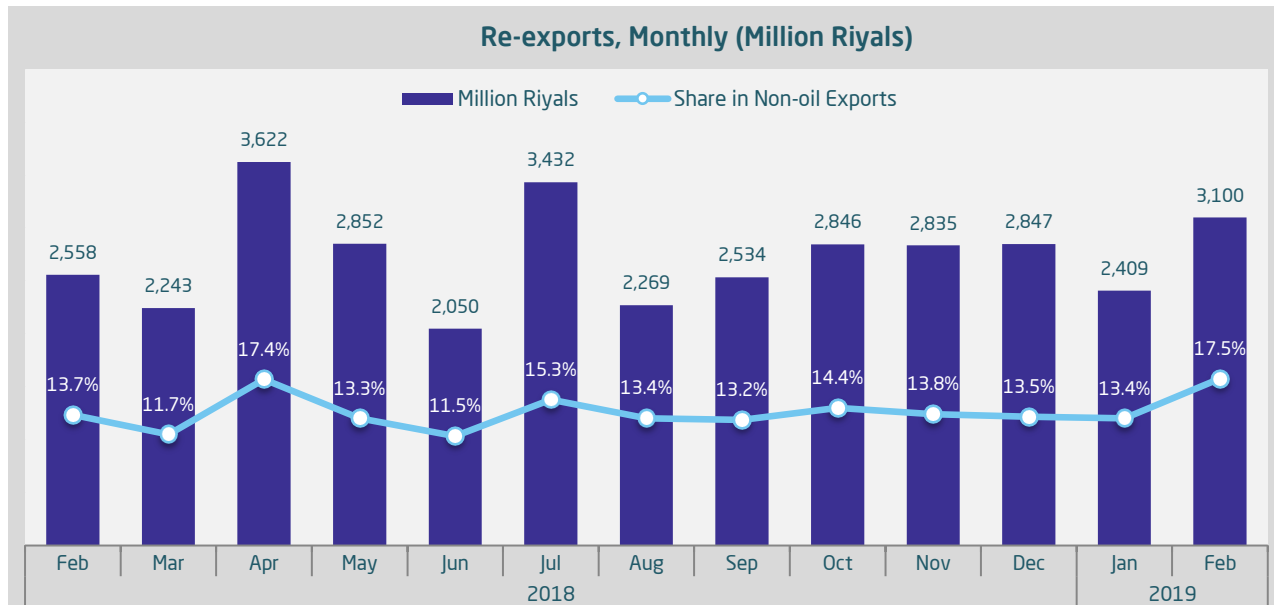




1.2.6. Re-exports

Products re-exported by Saudi Arabia amounted to 3 billion 100 million riyals in February 2019 compared to 2 billion 558 million riyals in February 2018, up by 541 million riyals or 21.2% over that period.

United Arab Emirates was the main destination for the re-exports, accounting for 26.7% of the total re-exports of the Kingdom in February 2019, followed by Bahrain with a share of 11.5%.





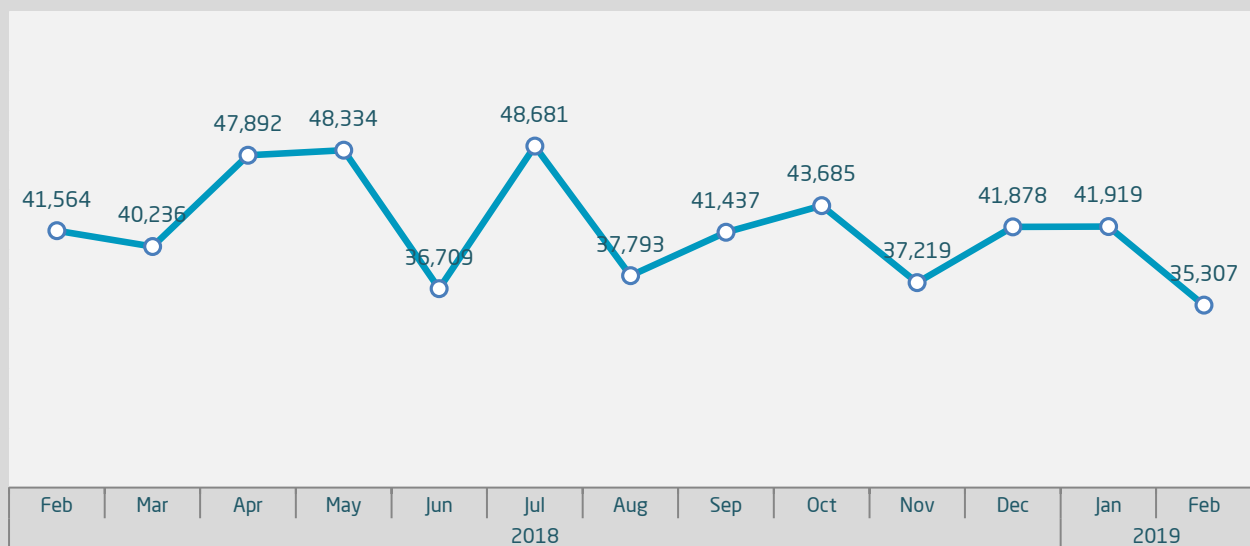
2. Merchandise Imports

2.1. Developments in Imports

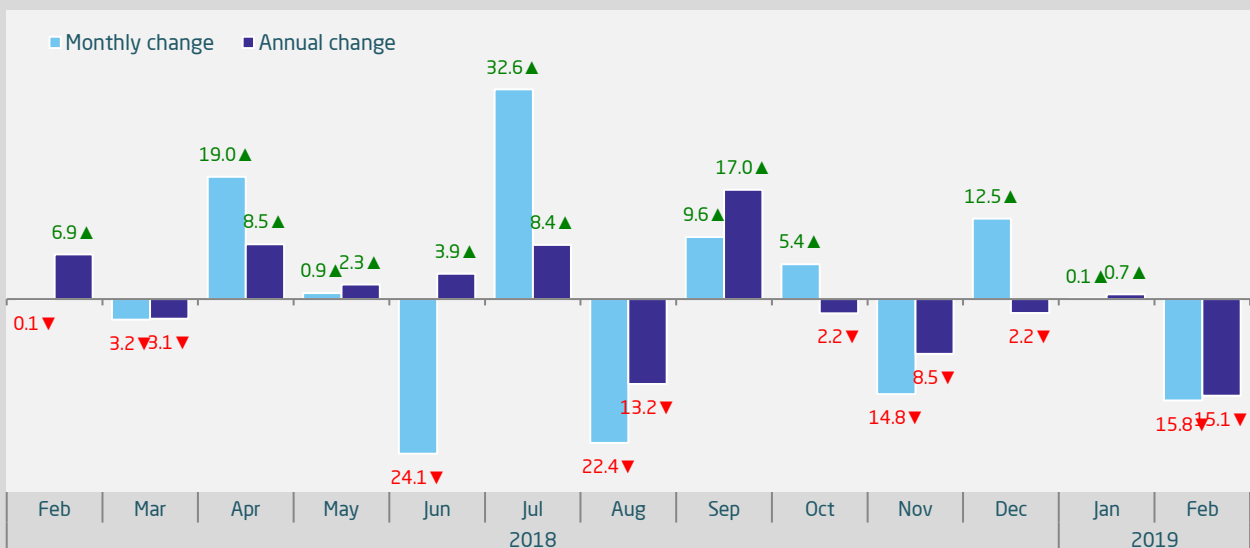
Total merchandise imports of Saudi Arabia amounted to 35 billion 307 million riyals in February 2019 compared to 41 billion 564 million riyals in February 2018, corresponding to a decrease of 6 billion 257 million riyals or 15.1% over that period.

Merchandise imports in February 2019 were also lower than those in the preceding month (January 2019) by 6 billion 612 million riyals or 15.8%.

Change in Imports (%)



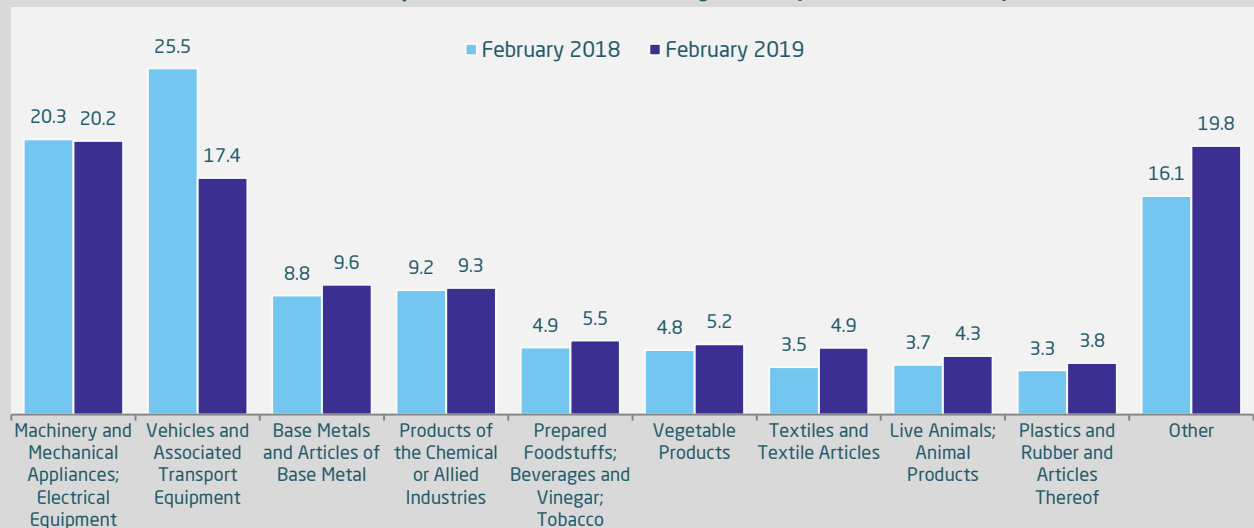

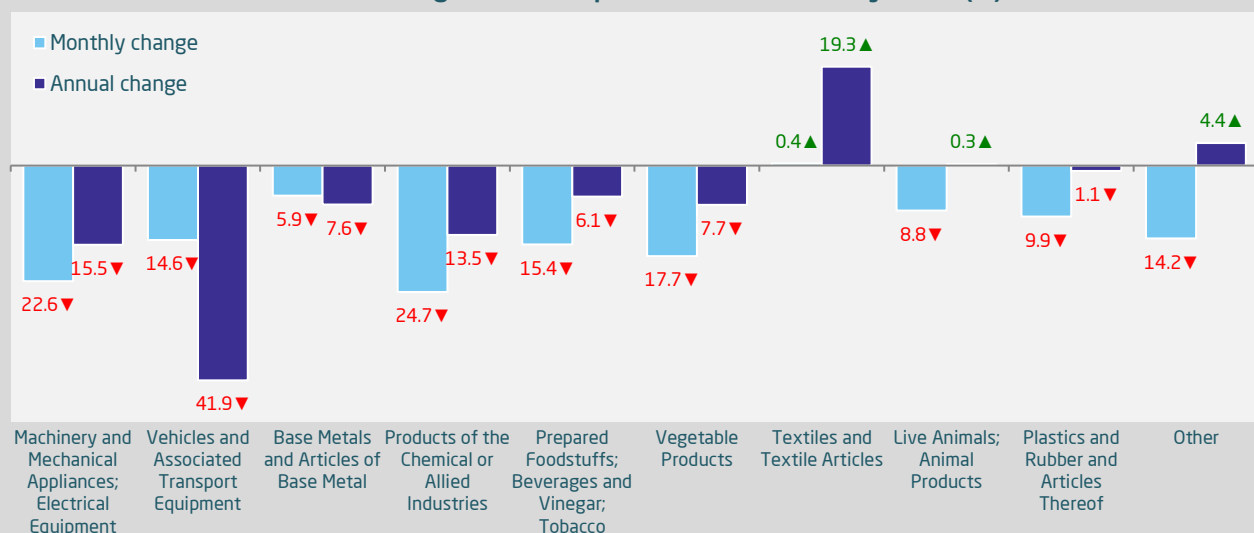

Main Import Products in February 2019 (Share in total, %)



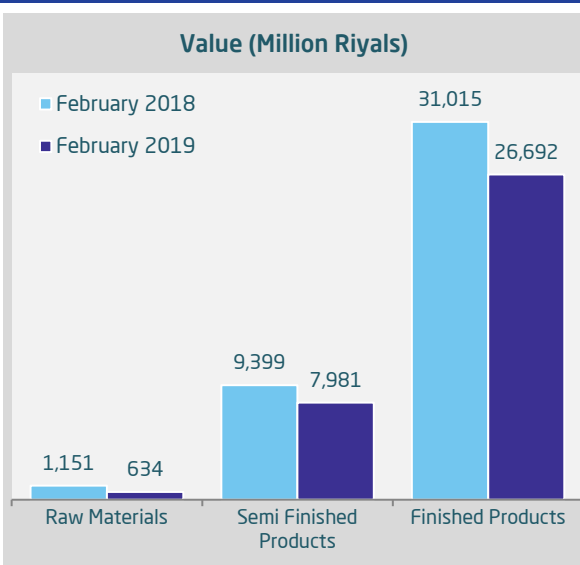
Change in Main Import Products, February 2019 (%)



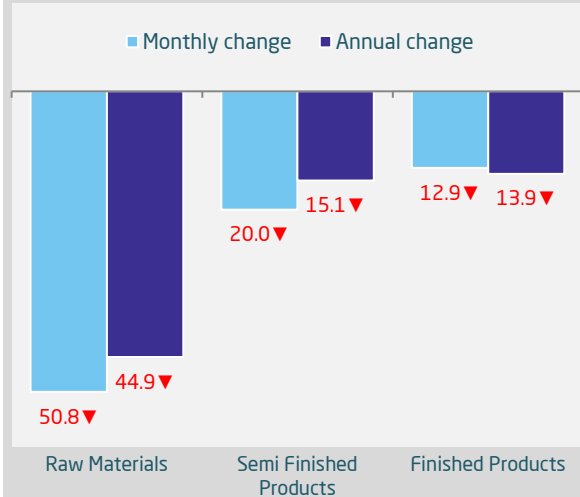

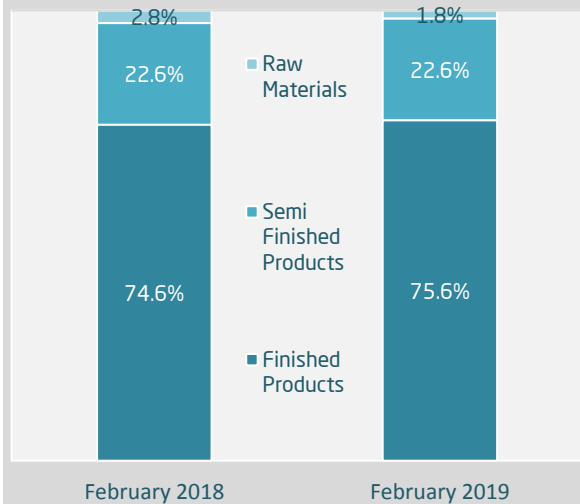
Imports by Nature of Items



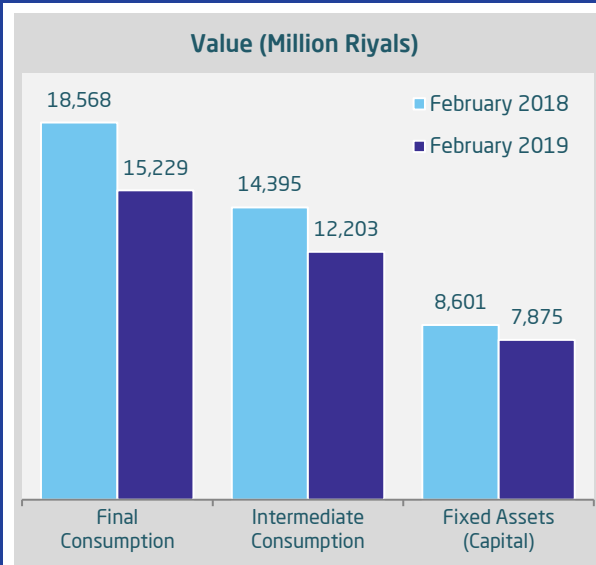
Change in February 2019 (%)



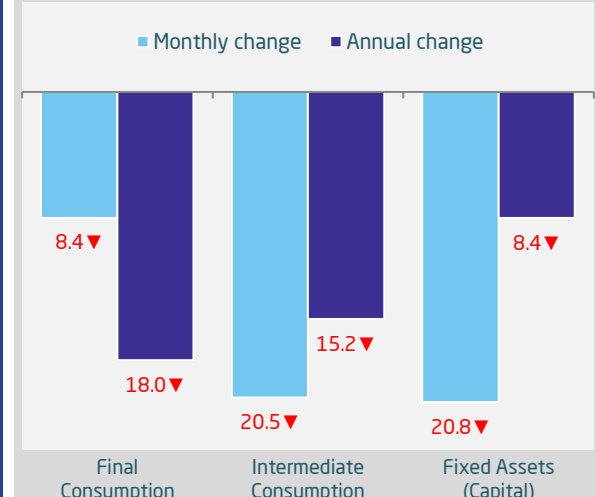
Share in Total Imports



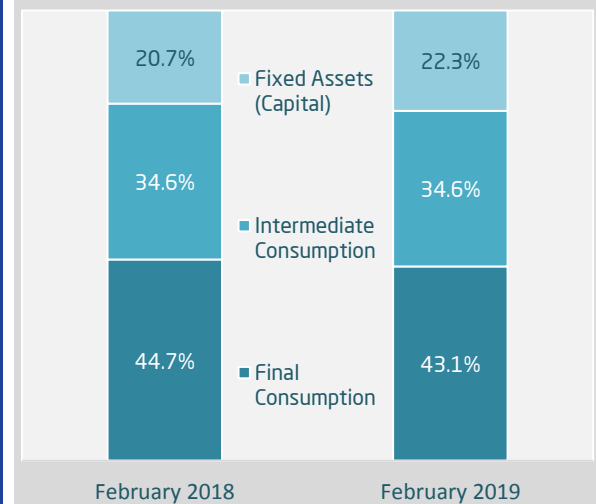
Imports by Utilization of Items

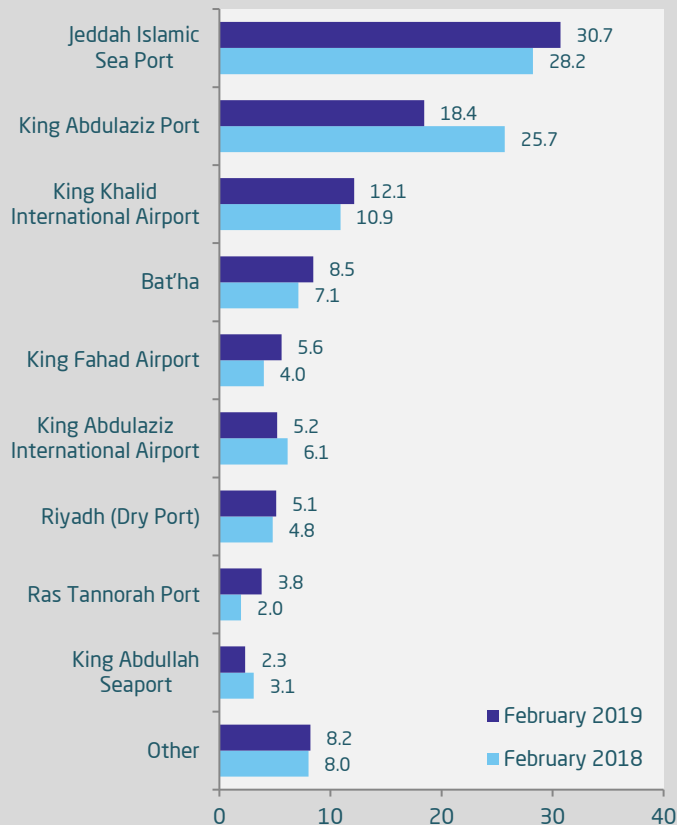

(% of total imports)



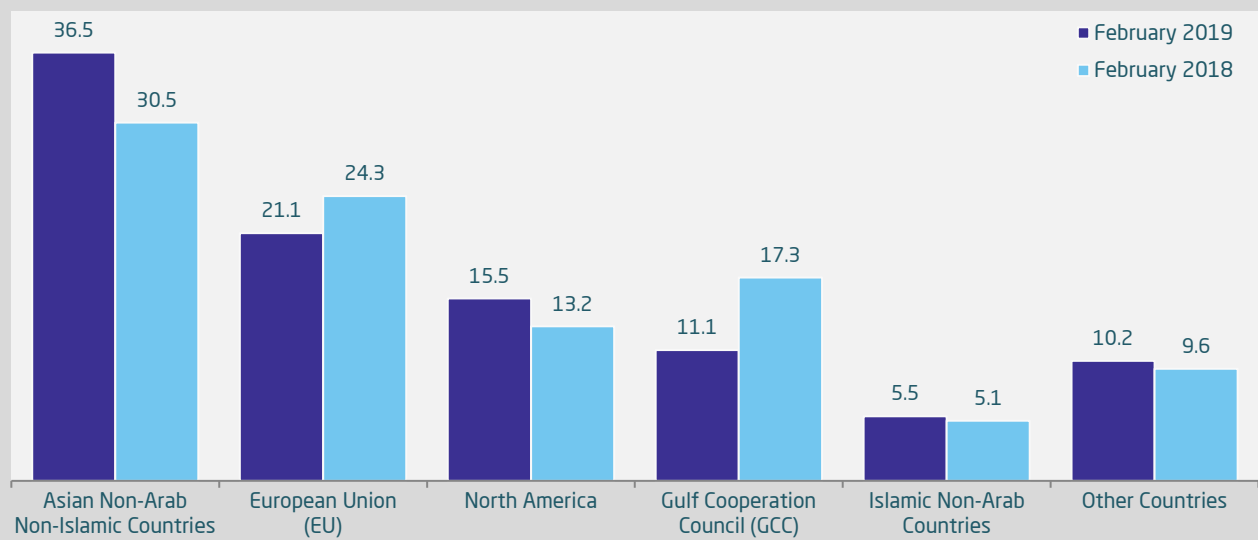

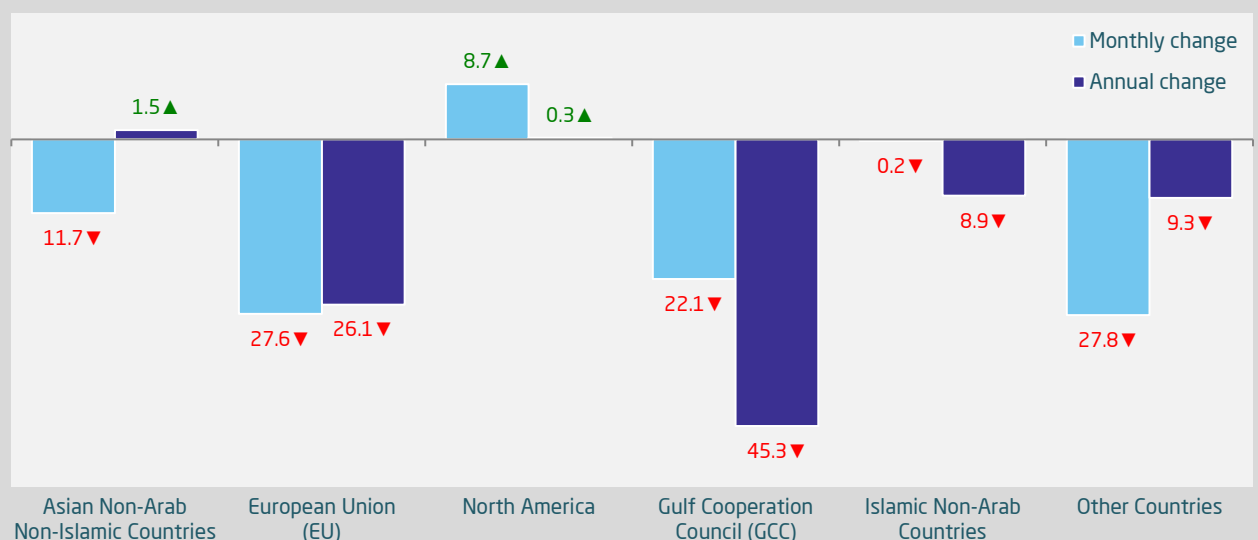

Change in Imports by Group of Countries, February 2019 (%)



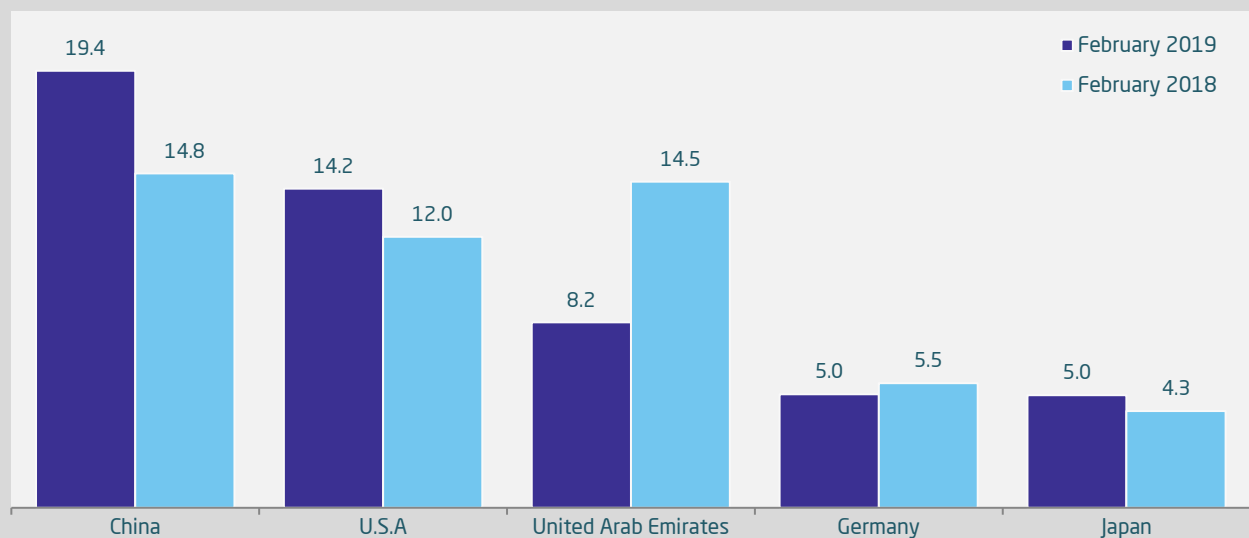

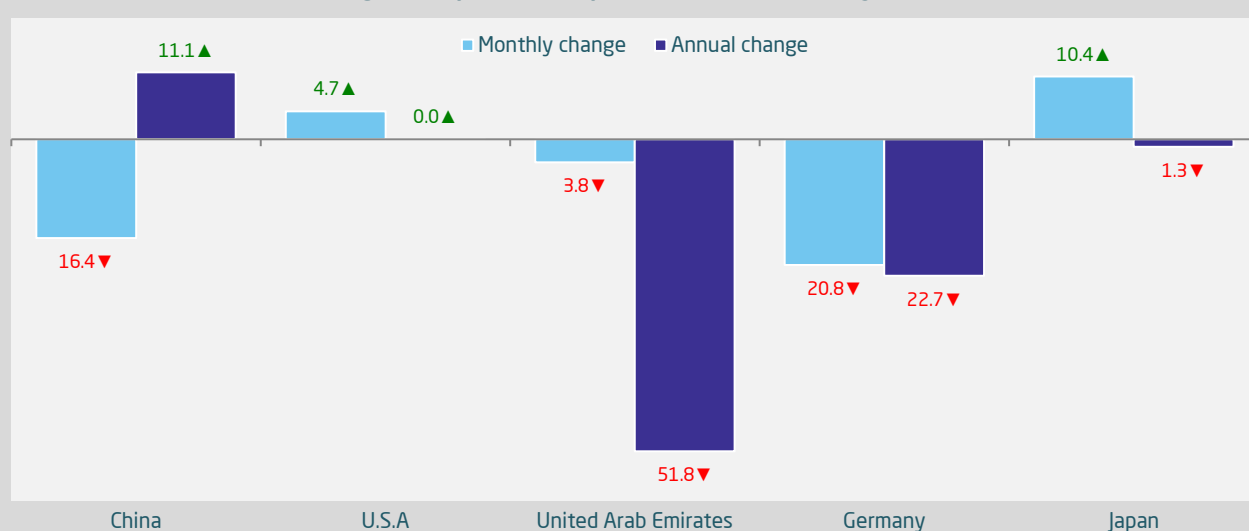

3. Trade Volume and Trade Balance

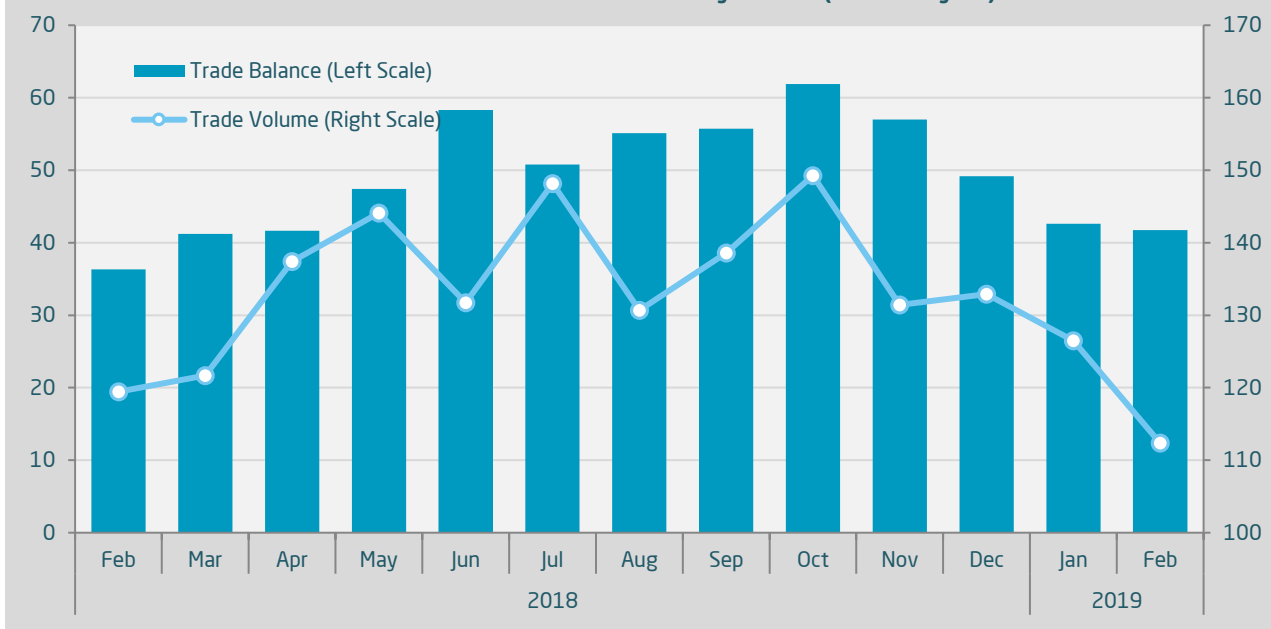
Merchandise trade volume of Saudi Arabia amounted to 112 billion 361 million riyals in February 2019 compared to 119 billion 462 million riyals in February 2018, corresponding to a decrease of 7 billion 101 million riyals or 5.9%. On the other hand, the Kingdom recorded a surplus of 41 billion 746 million riyals in its merchandise trade in February 2019, up by 5 billion 413 million riyals from the surplus of 36 billion 333 million riyals registered in February 2018.

4. Ratio of Non-oil Exports to Imports, Monthly

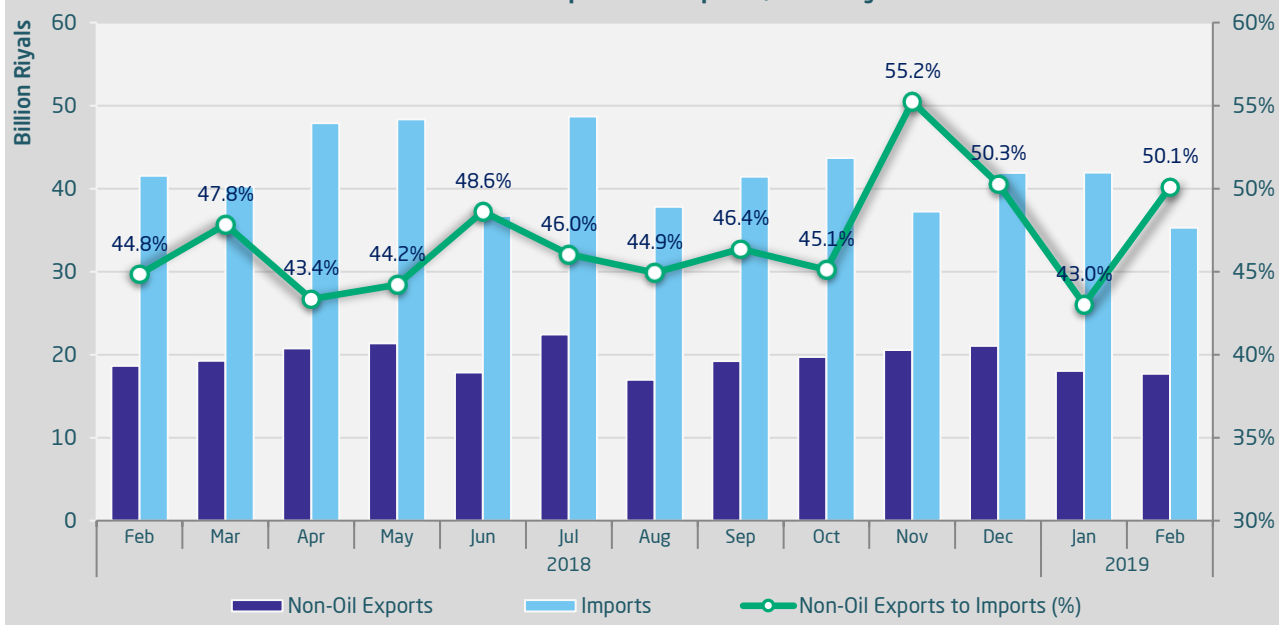
Non-oil exports decreased from 18 billion 635 million riyals in February 2018 to 17 billion 687 million riyals in February 2019 while imports decreased from 41 billion 564 million riyals to 35 billion 307 million riyals over the same period. Accordingly, the ratio of non-oil exports to imports increased to 50.1% in February 2019 from 44.8% in February 2018 as a result of a larger decline in imports (15.1%) than in non-oil exports (5.1%) over that period.

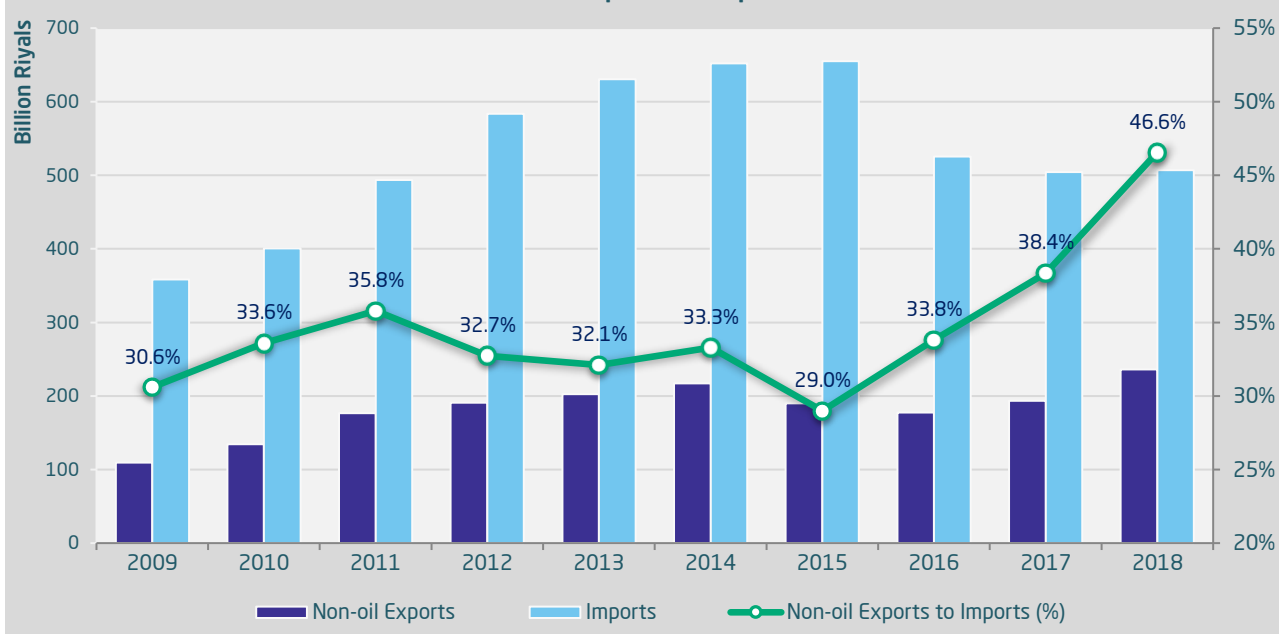
Non-oil exports increased from 193 billion 479 million riyals in 2017 to 236 billion 78 million riyals in 2018 while imports increased from 504 billion 447 million riyals to 507 billion 42 million riyals over the same period. Accordingly, the ratio of non-oil exports to imports increased to 46.6% in 2018 from 38.4% in the previous year as a result of a higher increase in non-oil exports (22.0%) than in imports (0.5%) over the previous year.

Ratio of Non-oil Exports to Imports, Annual





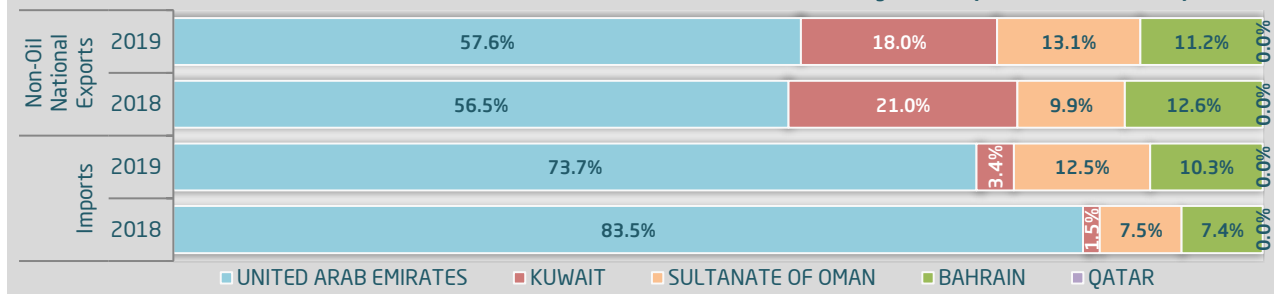
6. Trade between Saudi Arabia and GCC Countries

Non-oil exports of Saudi Arabia of national origin to the GCC countries amounted to 2 billion 163 million riyals in February 2019 compared to 2 billion 502 million riyals in February 2018, with a decrease of 339 million riyals or 13.6% over that period. Saudi Arabia's imports of goods from the GCC countries amounted to 3 billion 936 million riyals in February 2019 compared to 7 billion 202 million riyals in February 2018, down by 3 billion 266 million riyals or 45.3% over that period.

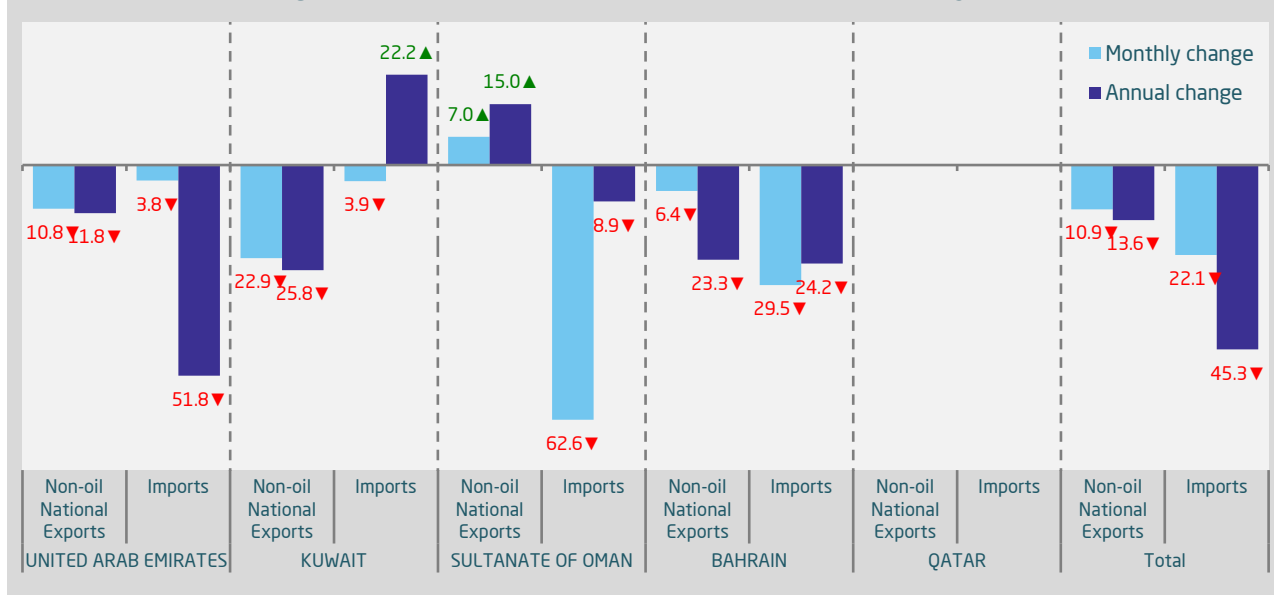
